USA J.O. Levels 5-10, FIG Age Group 1 and 2, FIG Juniors and Seniors.

1-3 Coaches allowed

A judge may be brought but not required

Unlimited acrobatic pairs/groups

5. Competition Program

USA J.O. Program: Winner determined by highest score

Age Group 1: Sum of 2 exercises determines winner

Age Group 2 - Seniors: Sum of the 3 exercises determines winner.

*If there are more than 15 pair/groups in any category, those pairs/groups will be split into smaller groups for competition.

6. Equipment: AAI Floor for training and competition

7. Deadlines for Entries and Financial Obligations

Provisional Registration due December 1, 2017.

Visa Form December 1, 2017.

Definitive-Nominative Registration due January 1, 2018.

Delegations are responsible for covering travel expenses, accommodation, meals, and entry fees.

The entry fee is refundable only if cancellations are made by January 1, 2018.

Each Country/Club is responsible for emailing a copy of all athlete competition music for WOGA Classic to **Ltwin@rocketmail.com**. Each routine must be a separate file in MP3 format. The file name should be the pair/group ID and the routine abbreviation (e.g. 145C)

Please bring a backup CD with music in case there is an equipment malfunction during the event, or if there is a change in music.

All music files must be emailed by February 7, 2018.
