# THE 2ND WORLD JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS IN SPORTS ACROBATICS INSTAR CUPHELD IN BEIJING

In the golden season of autumn blessed with refreshing air and agreeable weather, Beijing, an ancient and magnificant city in China, had the honor to host the Second World Junior Championships in Sports Acrobatics from September 26-28, 1991. As the venue for the championships, the Capital Gymnasium, which is the largest of its kind in Beijing, had made all the preparations necessary to welcome the young athletes from around the world.

Eighty athletes from Australia, Bulgaria, France, the United Kingdom, Germany, Japan, Portugal, the United States and China participated in this grand event of sports acrobatics (China Team B also participated in the championships as a non-place winning competitor). Among those attending or working for the occasion were Mr. Stoil Sotirov, Bulgaria, President of the International Federation of Sports Acrobatics; Mr. Kurt Becker, Germany, IFSA Vice President; Mr. Masato Ikegami, Japan and Mrs. Zhang Suyang, China, members of the IFSA Executive Committee. 
members attending included Mr. Joao Fernandes, Portugal; Mr. David Harrison, Great Britain; Mr. Takeichi Mihata, Japan and Mr. Jiang Longnan, China. From the Judges Committee, members attending the Championships included Mr. Mathieu Roz, France; Mr. Wang Xuliang, China and others.

Thanks to the good and orderly organization of its host the Chinese Sports Acrobatics Association, which provided excellent sports facilities and apparatus for the games, and to the kind and full cooperation of all participating delegations and friends, the Second World Junior Championships proceeded smoothly and were crowned with success.

In addition to the competition, participants also did some sightseeing, which made their stay in Beijing more colorful and enjoyable. As a Chinese saying goes, "You're not a hero or heroine unless you climb to the top of the Great Wall". Well, it seems that all of our friends coming from various countries to the Championships are now heroes and heroines.

The championships are a review of the junior athletes of the world and offer an opportunity for them to display their best performance, skills and abilities. In competition, these boys and girls have lived up to their countries' expectations, demonstrating high level skills such as the triple back salto performed by the Bulgarian Women's Group, whip back to double salto backwards stretched in the French Women's Tumbling, double back salto layout to back handspring to double back salto stretched which was performed in the USA Men's Tumbling and high handstand with one arm performed by the British Women's Pair. Women's Group of Germany, Women's Tumbling and Women's Pair of Japan, and Women's Pair and Women's Group of Portugal all have made remarkable progress.

The performance of the Chinese athletes was outstanding. They have done quite a number of new and difficult elements, such as: one arm side scale on high raised legs, performed by the Men's Pair and throw and horizontal double turn in the air, done by the Women's Group. Handstand on the feet of a partner who is in handstand position was particularly enjoyed by the spectators. This original and difficult movement, unexpected and unimagined

before in sports acrobatics, has not only won appreciation and ovation from spectators; but has also enriched the repertoire of the sport and widened our horizon of creative imagination.

It is indeed a pity that the athletes from the Soviet Union, Poland and other countries did not join us in the Championships and that some of the entering teams have failed to send all of their best athletes enlisted. Otherwise, the competition of the championships could have been even more exciting and China would not have been able to win so many gold medals as it did.

During the period of the championships, with a view to promoting the development of sports acrobatics in Asia, representatives from China, Japan, DPR Korea, Hong Kong and India held consultations on the establishment of an Asian organization for sports acrobatics. The Asian Sports Acrobatics Federation is expected to come into being soon. The Federation, once established, will surely contribute to developing sports acrobatics in Asia and will help the beautiful and attractive sport enter the Olympic arena at an early date.

The 2nd World Junior Championships in Sports Acrobatics has come to a close, but the beautiful memory it has left on all of us will remain fresh in our mind for a long time to come.

We have seen, through the game, the future and hope of world sports acrobatics. In the months and years ahead, young and new athletes of sports acrobatics will open new and splendid chapters in the annals of sports acrobatics history.

# **DOPING CONTROL**

In September 1991 at the World Junior Championships in Beijing, gold medal winners were obliged to undergo tests for drug abuse. All tests proved negative. This was the first occasion when doping control tests have been used at a World Sports Acrobatics event, and complies with the requirements of the International Olympic Committee.

In Lisbon in November 1991, at the European Sports Acrobatics Championships seven athletes were selected at random for drug tests. All, again, proved negative.

It is a decision of the Executive Committee of the IFSA that tests for drug abuse will take place at all major international events.
