Novice to FIG level

The competition will take place on a sprung floor.

It will include Novice level straight-line routines, which is the entry level for acrobatic gymnastics competitors, enabling enthusiastic beginners to take their first steps into competitive acrobatics without the need for music or choreographed routines.

The competition will also include all NDP grades (Grades 1-5, Aspire and IDP), all FIG levels (11-16, 12-18, 13-19 and Senior), Adult and Disability Acrobatics.



4 Grades/levels (see Rules section for more details)

The Honiton Invitational includes the following acrobatic gymnastics levels:

- 4.1 Novice: Levels 1-4 (straight-line routines without music or choreography)
- 4.2 NDP Grades 1-5 + Aspire & IDP
- 4.3 FIG levels 11-16 (Pre-Youth), 12-18 (Youth), 13-19 (Junior) & Senior
- 4.4 Disability acrobatics
- 4.5 Adult acrobatics

5 Age limits

There are no age restrictions for the categories/levels, except Novice (which has three age brackets for each level).



7 Venue setup

It is expected that Honiton Gymnastics Centre will be set-up as below for the competition. If this changes closer to the competition, clubs will be notified.

7.1 Presenting/walk into position

Gymnasts should be ready two routines before they compete in the area labelled 'March-on'. This time will be shown as **Waiting Area** on the Acro Companion online **Starting Order.** When signalled, they will walk from the area labelled 'March on' in the above diagram and straight into position on the floor. There will be no need to present on the edge of the floor or before the start of the routine.

8 General competition guidelines

Tie Breaks

All ties, at all levels, will follow NDP 11 rules. That is, the winner is the partnership with: The highest E-score, followed by the highest E+A-score of the combined exercise(s). If two or three exercises are performed it is the highest E-score, followed by the highest A-score of the sum of the exercises.

If a tie still remains the tie will not be broken.

8.1 Guidelines: Novice (straight-line routines)

Categories

Gymnasts can be entered into the following categories

- 1. Novice Levels 1-4 (Age 9 & Under)
- 2. Novice Levels 1-4 (Age 12 & Under)
- 3. Novice Levels 1-4 (Age 13+)

Guidelines

- Performed on a 12m length of sprung floor
- Side to side (NOT front to back): from the judges' view, gymnasts must start at the right-hand-side of the floor, then perform their moves from right to left across the floor
- Moves must follow the exact order as set out in the Novice code
- Music is NOT permitted
- Static partner elements must be held for three seconds

Judging Rules/Requirements

- Normal technical execution judging rules apply, with a mark out of 10 (which is doubled), minus any penalties
- Routines are NOT judged for artistry
- There is NOT a difficulty mark
- Tariff sheets are NOT required

8.2 Guidelines: Pre-Youth, Youth and Junior (11-16, 12-18 & 13-19)

There are no finals in this competition. The winner is decided by adding together:

- The total of Balance and Dynamic scores for Pre-Youth.
- The total of Balance, Dynamic and Combined scores for Youth & Junior

8.3 Guidelines: Senior

There are no finals in this competition. The winner is decided by adding together the total of Balance, Dynamic and Combined scores. There are also individual medals for Balance and Dynamic routine winners. Rules: https://bit.ly/4mzRHJN

8.4 Guidelines: Disability Acrobatics

8.5 Guidelines: Adult Acrobatics (Age 18+)

Open to anyone aged 18 and over, regardless of experience or ability. The event creates a fun and relaxed atmosphere where competitors can meet like-minded people whilst showcasing their gymnastics skills to one another.

Guidelines

- 1. 1 x Combined routine required with a combination of **5** Balance/Dynamic moves (any NDP level/grade or using FIG moves)
- 2. Must have at least one Balance (3-second holds) and one Dynamic move
- 3. Combination of **3** individual elements (any level/grade)
- 4. Two-minute routine to music is required
- 5. Partnerships can be either: Men's Pair, Women's Pair, Mixed Pair (girl as top), Trio (either Mixed, Men's or Women's) and Men's Group
- 6. There is no maximum age restrictions; only a minimum age of 18 years.
- 7. Age bonus: 0.1 bonus for every full 5 years over the age of 20 years for each partner (e.g. Top is 25 & Base is 39 = 0.4 bonus).
- 8. Competition attire can be matching leotards (with or without shorts), gym club T-shirts or polo shirts with leggings or shorts, vest tops, tank tops.

Adult Judging rules

- 1. The routine is marked out of 10.00 for execution (then doubled) and 10.00 for artistry. The CJP will then add the age bonus and award an arbitrary bonus of between 0.0 & 0.5 for difficulty.
- 2. Standard judging rules will apply for technical execution & artistry.

9 Competition Entry Fees

Cost

Entry is:

- £30 per gymnast per discipline in Grades and FIG
- £15 per gymnast for Novice entries

Double entries are allowed (but only if a gymnast competes in a different discipline). Gymnasts must pay for each discipline that they compete in. A gymnast cannot double entry in the same discipline (ie they cannot compete in two different women's pairs).

Closing Date

The closing date for entries is 23:59 on Sunday 24 August 2025. Entry fees must be paid by this date to confirm entries.

Limited numbers!

To ensure a smooth competition, we will be limiting the weekend's competition to a maximum of 350 routines and we won't be able accept further entries once we reach this number, so please ensure your entries reach us as soon as possible! 10 Entry Process via Acro Companion

- **Existing Users:** Sign in to your Acro Companion account here: https://www.acro-companion.com/login/sign-in
- **New Users:** Register for an account here: https://www.acro-companion.com/login/sign-up. Email Acro Companion at support@acro-companion.com and provide them with the following information:
 - Name of your club
 - Which Federation you're connected to (GB)
 - Country
 - Address
 - The email of the person who will be the manager of your club in Acro Companion (the one you have registered with above) Acro Companion will reply once they have created the club.

Step-by-Step Guide (after your club has been created by Acro Companion, log into your Acro Companion account):

- 1. Click the Suitcase icon (top left corner).
- 2. Select "Change Organisation" at the top (orange bar)
- 3. Under 'Clubs' select the tickbox for your club
- 4. Select "Members/Registrations."
- 5. **Members (top menu):** Add details of ALL competing gymnasts and coaches (Click the + Button on the right to add them. It's not necessary to fill in all details just the compulsory ones)
- 6. **Teams (top menu):** Group your gymnasts into their partnerships, choose their discipline and grade, and add photos (optional...but great if you would like to see your gymnasts' photos on the scoreboard!).
- 7. Register for the Honiton Invitational:
 - Choose "Register for Competitions" (right-hand side menu at the top right menu).
 - Select "Acrobatic" and then "Honiton Invitational Competition."
- 8. Select your teams!: Select your teams in the Teams menu at the top
- 9. Follow the tabs along the top to complete the entire registration process, including adding coaches and judges and their judging days. When happy, click the Send in Registration button! The Honiton team will then approve your registration and assign you tariff sheets.

Only one Acro Companion account per club allowed for this competition.

Even if your club has different groups, use just one account to add gymnasts and form partnerships. When creating partnerships, add their coach's email to give the coach permission to create and manage their tariff sheets and add music The coach must have their own Acro Companion account to access the tariff sheets and add music.

11 Payments

Following entry on Acro Companion, all payments must be sent, including reference code [YOUR CLUB NAME] INV2025, to: A/C: 65686249 Sort Code: 089299. Entries will only be confirmed when payment has been made. No refunds after the entry closing date.

12 Judge requirements

A full and balanced panel of judges is essential for ensuring the competition runs fairly. There is a £150 charge if you cannot bring a judge with you, which should be added to your club's payment. This charge enables us to organise for another judge to attend and for us to pay travel and accommodation expenses. Please let us know as soon as possible if you won't be able to bring a judge so we can ensure their space is filled. Please add your judges and contact details to Acro Companion when you register.

13 Tariff sheets & Music

Tariff Sheets and Music are via Acro **Companion no later than Friday 3 October.** Adult Acrobatics and Novice Levels do not do tariff sheets. Adult Acrobatics partnerships should email their music to honitongymclub.org. Changes are possible until midnight **on 9 October.** Final approvals will then be made and music downloaded to our system, so no further changes are possible after this. Please bring a copy of your tariff sheet and backup of your music on a pen drive in case of issues.

14 Additional competition day info

Balance or Dynamic first?

All partnerships with more than one routine will compete BALANCE first, DYNAMIC second (and COMBINED third if competing in Youth, Junior or Senior).

Food onsite

Refreshments and hot & cold food will be available to purchase all weekend in the marquee. We also expect to have freshly-made pizza on sale.

Photos

A photo service will be provided by DE Photos

Cuppas and food for coaches

Coaches will receive complimentary lunch each day and will have access to tea or coffee for free all day!

Presentations

Medal ceremonies (for podium places) are held at the end of each session. We expect three presentation ceremonies per day, and all gymnasts receive participation medals.

Scores

Up-to-the-minute scores are available throughout the event via Acro Companion.

There will be a Livestream of the competition throughout the weekend. More details will be sent out about this nearer to the competition.
