6. Delegation Size

Each delegation may include:

- 1 Head of delegation
- 1 Team Manager
- Unlimited Coaches
- 1 Doctor
- 1 Physiotherapist
- At least 1 judge is mandatory – 500€ penalty fee (FIG International judges will have 20% discount in the accommodation package)
- Unlimited acrobatic P/G

7. Age Limit

Beginners: from 8 years old to 15 years old – No height deduction
Pre-youth: from 9 years old to 16 years old – No height deduction
Open: No age control – No height deduction
Youth: from 10 years old to 18 years old
Junior: from 11 years old to 19 years old
Senior: minimum 13 years old

8. Competition Programme

Qualifications and Finals in all 5 categories.

Qualifications (Pre-Youth, Youth, Junior, Senior): 1 Balance and 1 Dynamic routine.

Qualifications (Open): 1 Combined routine (Difficulty calculated as FIG Youth)

General Rules: maximum difficulty 55 Value (+10V over limit)

Qualifications (Beginners): 1 Combined routine (Difficulty calculated as FIG 11-16 Age Group)

General Rules:

Pairs: choose 2 balance elements from 11-16 compulsory tables + 1 optional element from FIG Tables and 2 dynamic elements from 11-16 compulsory tables + 1 optional element from FIG Tables. Cannot be chosen element from FIG Tables that are in 11-16 compulsory tables too.

Groups: choose 1 pyramid from 11-16 compulsory tables + 1 optional pyramid from FIG Tables (only 2 static hold 3 seconds required) and 2 dynamic elements from 11-16 compulsory tables + 1 optional element from FIG Tables. The optional pyramid may be selected from one of the same categories used in the compulsory element. Cannot be chosen element from FIG Tables that are in 11-16 compulsory tables too.

Individuals: 3 elements, at least 1 agility or 1 tumbling (NO Salto required)

Pre-Youth:	Age Group 11-16 FIG rules
Youth/Open:	Age Group 12-18 FIG rules
Junior:	Age Group 13-19 FIG rules
Senior:	Senior FIG rules

Finals: top six (if 1 to 8 P/G), top eight (if 9 to 16 P/G) or top twelve (if more than 16 P/G)

Beginners/Open: Combined – Finals starts from zero

Pre-Youth: Balance or Dynamic in accordance with FIG rules for 11-16 (starts from zero)

Youth, Junior and Senior: Combined – Finals starts from zero

All the FIG rules considered as valid in 2026:

- Code of Points (2025-2028)
- World Age Group Rules (latest version)
- All the official FIG newsletter will be applied

11. Registration deadlines and Finance Obligations

Provisional entry: 1st April 2026 (no payments - no reservation)
 Definitive entry: 1st May 2026 (30% accommodation + entry fee + no judge fee)
 Nominative entry: 12th June 2026 (no payment)
 Entry forms will be available on our website at www.turinacrocup.com (only in English language)

The remaining payment **must be made** before or at accreditation time.

- The entry fee is not refundable at all
- The accommodation is only refundable if cancellation are made not later than **7 days before check-in**
- All delegations must bring (at least) 1 judge – NO JUDGE Penalty: 500€ (International Judges have 20% discount in the accommodation package)
- We kindly ask to all participants to be booked through the OC – the **entry fee is doubled for delegation not booking** through the OC

12. Equipment

Warm up floor:	Gymnova (foam system)
Competition floor:	Janssen-Fritsen mod. Moscow (spring system)

13. Entry fee

50 Euro	per gymnast to join the Turin Acro Cup if booking through the OC
100 Euro	per gymnast to join the Turin Acro Cup if NOT booking through the OC

14. Accommodation

Hotel (i.e. [Blu Hotel](#), [B&B Borgaro Torinese](#), [Hotel GranTorino](#), [Glis Hotel](#)*)

Single room / Full board	200€/ night/ person
Double room / Full board	150€/ night/ person
Triple room / Full board	130€/ night/ person

Hostel (very short room availability, need to ask before confirming)

Six people room (shared bathroom) / Full board	110€/ night/ person
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Full board is included in the accommodation package, breakfast in the hotel.

*The hotels names are just an example of the type of the hotels used in the previous editions. They may change after booking (keeping the same quality) depending on numbers of persons interested in, and their availability.

If you have booked through the OC, transfer by bus to and from Turin International Airport and/or Turin Railway station to the official hotel and transfer to/from official hotel and from/to gym hall, will be provided in the accommodation package by the OC.

15. Airport transfer

Transfer to/from Turin Airport: 25 Euro/ person/ one way (only if you do not have booked through the OC)

If 5 or more persons (**if less than 5, please ask to the OC for a quotation**):

Transfer to/from Milan Malpensa Airport: 50 Euro/ person/ one way

Transfer to/from Milan Linate Airport: 60 Euro/ person/ one way

Transfer to/from Milan Bergamo Airport: 80 Euro/ person/ one way

16. *Extra Meals*

It will be possible to ask for extra meals at very latest the day before the needing of an extra meal. Each extra meal will cost 20 Euro.

The extra meal will be served at the official restaurant of the competition, and it will be possible to join the delegation that booked through the OC.

17. *Visa*

If you need an official invitation to obtain a visa to travel to Italy, please contact the OC as soon as possible.

18. *Insurance*

All delegations are responsible for having the necessary insurance coverage against accidents and illness. The OC will not be responsible for any liabilities in case of accident or illness.

19. *Medical Services*

Red Cross personnel will be present during competitions and training sessions.

20. *Tariff sheets and Music*

The deadline to upload the TS and music is set on June 26th 2026.

All the participants will receive his own login and password to upload all the files in our scoring system.

In any case we would like to ask you to bring with you a backup copy of all the competition music.

21. *Accreditation*

All participants and officials are required to always wear accreditation cards. At accreditation, the HoD must check the correct names of their complete delegation verify accommodation requirements and make the necessary payments.

The accreditation card is personal, non-transferable, and compulsory to control access to training and competition hall, functions, official transport, lunches, and dinners.

If you have lost your accreditation card, you should buy a new one for the price of 150 Euro.

22. *Streaming Live*

The whole competition will be live streamed using Twitch streaming live service. The video will be embedded on the competition website at www.turinacrocup.com.

The OC will provide the live streaming service totally **for free**.

23. *Competition party*

The Welcome party will be held on Saturday evening.

It's **NOT** included in the accommodations package for delegations and it will include transportation from the gym hall to the venue and back to the hotel booked through the OC or to the gym hall if not.

It will cost 30 Euro each person for delegations that will book through the OC.

It will cost 50 Euro each person for delegations that will NOT book through the OC.

Delegations who have booked through the OC and who will not join to the competition party will receive regular dinner at the competition restaurant.
